

General Park Rules

1. NO profanity will be tolerated.
2. NO alcoholic beverages allowed.
3. NO pets allowed.
4. NO outside food or coolers allowed. EXCEPTION: Team coolers may be brought into the park for team use only.
5. Soft tossing of any type of ball (baseball, softball, soccer ball, tennis ball, etc.) against any fence structure is NOT permitted. This applies to all fence lines, including the batting cages.
6. Head coaches are responsible for the team's parents and assistant coaches' behavior; one warning will be given, but if bad behavior continues, necessary precautions will be taken.
7. If a questionable call, or other conflict, arises in a game, only the head coach is to approach the umpire for discussion of the call (this discussion will last no longer than 5 minutes).
8. Each team will submit a written lineup to the umpire and scorekeeper 5 minutes before the game, and each team will be allowed 10 minutes of warm up before the game.
9. Only coaches discuss outs, problems with a player, or time left in the game with the scoreboard, scorebook, and clock operators.
10. There will be a \$50.00 fee for each protest. This fee will be refunded if the ruling is in favor of the protesting party.
11. Games will start as close as possible to the scheduled time for each ball game, if a child comes to the game late he/she will be at the end of the batting order.
12. Any unruly actions taken upon or damage to South Lincoln Sportsplex property will be turned over to the local authorities.
13. If a coach, or assistant coach, has to be ejected, that person will meet with the Vice President of the field, and the President of the Park to discuss future attendance at the Park.
14. If a ballgame is presently going on, and there is a considerable time remaining, the next game's teams may warm up on another ball field in the outfield. No teams will warm up on the side of the field.
15. If bad weather arises while a game is in play, the umpire behind the plate has the right to call the game as he/she sees necessary.
